

Endavo Media Management System (EMMS) – Release Notes

Release Date: June 18, 2026

This release introduces a modernized Playlist management experience, new ordering controls for App Builder lists, improved recovery tools for live restreaming, and responsive interface enhancements for EMMS.

New & Updated Features

Playlist Management on React

Playlist management has been migrated to React, providing a faster and more responsive workflow. We have also introduced several usability improvements, including enhanced search and collapsed views for individually added and excluded media lists by default, helping admins manage larger playlists more efficiently.

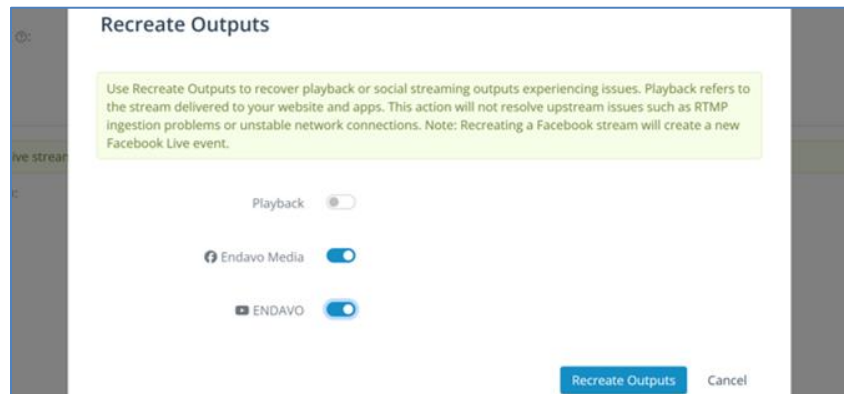
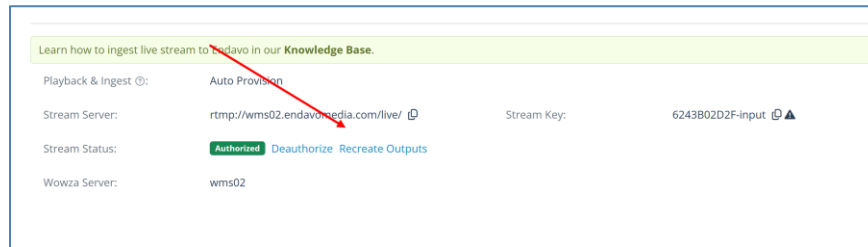
App Builder List Order Enhancement

App Builder media lists can now be configured to display content by “Oldest” order date in addition to the existing “Newest” option. This gives admins greater control over chronological and reverse-chronological presentation of media.

Recreate Outputs for Live & Virtual Live Events

Endavo account admins can now manually recreate individual Facebook and YouTube restream outputs for Live Events (LE) and Virtual Live Events (VLE). This provides a recovery option when a live stream ingest or other disruption interrupts a social restream during an active event, without requiring the entire event to be recreated.



Responsive EMMS Dashboard Improvements

Responsive UI enhancements have been made to the EMMS dashboard to improve usability and viewing on mobile devices and smaller screens.
